Uniform Test Instructions to Students

- Class Suspension, Tardiness, Being Late and Early Leave
 1. If any school suspension is announced by the Education Bureau during the Uniform Test period, the Uniform Test of that day will be postponed according to further arrangements by the School.
 2. Students who require sick leave should inform the school by phone calls in the morning the same day (before 8a.m.) and submit medical certificates and parent letters on the following day. However, no re-test will be arranged.
 3. Students who are absent will score zero in their Uniform test.
 4. Students who arrive at school after 8:15a.m. will be considered as late on uniform tests days.
 5. Students should be inspected their appearance and uniform and recorded for being late, if any, on uniform test days as usual. Students who have failed to dress properly should meet with the required teacher before sitting a test.
 6. Early leave is not permitted during tests.

- Violations of Uniform Test Regulations and Cheating
 1. Candidates should follow the instructions made by the invigilators when sitting a test, including the required preparation before the test and reminders made during the test. If candidates fail to follow the instructions, the invigilators are entitled to disqualify their test and no re-test will be arranged.
 2. Candidates should take the seat assigned by the invigilators and maintain absolute silence. They should not speak to other candidates nor disturb them.
 3. Before the test starts, make sure that no books, dictionaries, notes, paper, word-hidden pens, note pads, mobile phones, beepers, electronic dictionaries and communicative devices which can store or display texts (including watches which can display texts) can be found in/on the table or inside students' pockets. Otherwise, the student will be disqualified from the test.
 4. Candidates should take out all the necessary stationery from their pencil cases/boxes and put them on the tables. The pencil cases/boxes together with the switched off mobile phones should then be placed under the chairs.
 5. Candidates must not turn over the pages of the question paper and must not start working until they are instructed to do so. Otherwise, they will receive a mark penalty.
 6. The rough-work sheets supplied in the test will be collected at the end of the test by the invigilators. Any words written and diagrams drawn on the rough-work sheets will not be marked.
 7. If candidates are found to have mobile phones, beepers, electronic-dictionaries or other electronic devices that can store/display texts (including text-displaying watches) switched on during the test, they will receive a mark penalty.
 8. If candidates are found cheating, the school will disqualify their test and a zero score will be marked on their test paper. No re-test will be arranged. The school will meet with their parents and record the incident.
